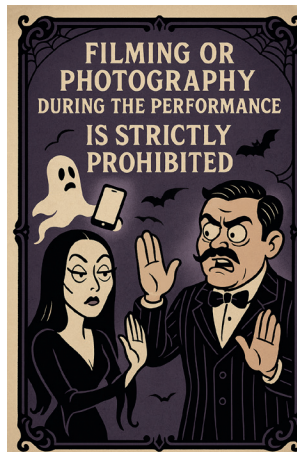

ABOUT THE SHOW

They're creepy and they're kooky, mysterious and spooky – and they've been entertaining audiences for generations. The Addams Family began life as a series of delightfully macabre comic strips by cartoonist Charles Addams, first published in The New Yorker in 1938. The gothic gang became household names thanks to the hit 1960s TV sitcom, before creeping back into pop culture through the much-loved 1990s and more recent animated movies.

In 2010, The Addams Family: The Musical made its Broadway debut, featuring a brand new story and a spine-tingling catchy score by Andrew Lippa, with a book by Marshall Brickman and Rick Elice (Jersey Boys). The show has since thrilled audiences worldwide with its perfect mix of spooky silliness, heartfelt humour and toe-tapping tunes.

This musical version follows Wednesday Addams – now a teenager – who has fallen in love with someone alarmingly normal. When she invites her boyfriend and his very average family over for dinner, chaos, secrets and hilarity ensue. With appearances from the whole Addams clan (and a few ghostly ancestors), it's a frightfully fun reminder that every family is weird in their own wonderful way.
